

## JOIN US FOR FORTY HOURS OF ADORATION: FEBRUARY 9-11, 2025

The Parish Feast Day of Our Lady of Lourdes will take

place this year on Tuesday, February 11, 2025. Considering this as a very important day for our parish, particularly during the Jubilee Year of Hope and the Eucharistic Revival, I am inviting you—your family, friends, classmates, colleagues, and EVERY PARISH MINISTRY, including our SCHOOL—to join us for FORTY HOURS OF ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT (The Holy Eucharist) beginning Sunday, February 9, 2025, at 3:00 PM.

The Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for certain hours until MIDNIGHT on Monday, February 10. It will then be exposed again on Monday, February 10, until MIDNIGHT on Tuesday, February 11. On our Feast Day, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed after the 9:00 AM Mass until 7:00 PM. A special Mass will follow at 7:30 PM.

The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed briefly if funerals are scheduled during this time. Please see the schedule forms in the vestibule for Ministry Groups and individuals to sign up to make a Holy Hour before Christ in the Blessed Sacrament.



#### Diocese of Rockville Centre Eucharistic Pilgrimage

During those days, Mary set out and traveled to the hill country in haste to the town of Judah, where she entered the house of Zechariah and greeted Elizabeth.

Luke 1: 39-40

Beginning on May 31, 2025, the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, two nine-day Eucharistic Pilgrimages will embark across Long Island, both culminating at St. Anthony's High School on Sunday June 8, 2025, for the celebration of our local Diocesan Eucharistic Congress. The Western Route will journey from St. Agnes Cathedral (Rockville Centre) through Nassau County, while the Eastern Route will journey from the Parish of Saint Therese of Lisieux (Montauk) through Suffolk County.

The Holy Eucharist will be carried in procession across the Diocese through many of our towns, schools, hospitals, cemeteries, and parishes. During this pilgrimage, there will be opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration, the celebration of Mass, Eucharistic Catechesis, Praise and Worship, public processions, and other Eucharistic celebrations. The People of God will be invited to walk with Jesus, truly present in the Holy Eucharist, pray in the pilgrim churches, and proclaim the Gospel to bystanders as Jesus passes through their towns.

#### **Perpetual Pilgrims**

The Diocese of Rockville Centre is inviting a dedicated group of young adults, ages 18 to 29, to apply to be *Perpetual Pilgrims*. These Perpetual Pilgrims will make the entire nine-day journey with the Lord in the Eucharist across the Diocese from May 31st - June 7<sup>th</sup> 2025, along with priest chaplains and an official pilgrimage team.

These pilgrims will represent the many young people from across Long Island who are on fire with Eucharistic love and missionary fervor. Applicants should be in good physical condition, capable of walking long distances, and committed to Christ, the teachings of his Church, and ongoing intellectual and spiritual formation.

## Requirements for Obtaining a Plenary Indulgence for the Jubilee Year of Hope:

- Visit the Jubilee Cross at St. Agnes Cathedral
- Make a Sacramental Confession shortly before or after the visit to the Jubilee Cross
- Be spiritually present in the Holy Eucharist
- Pray for the Holy Father and his intentions

"This is the Jubilee. This is the season of hope in which we are invited to rediscover the joy of meeting the Lord." – Pope Francis

The faithful of Long Island can attain this Plenary Indulgence by making a pilgrimage to THE CATHEDRAL of ST. AGNES and praying at the 2025 JUBILEE YEAR CROSS enshrined at the Cathedral and installed by Bishop John O. Barres.

#### **Pilgrimages**

The faithful, pilgrims of hope, will be able to obtain the Jubilee Indulgence granted by the Holy Father if they undertake a pious pilgrimage to any sacred jubilee site:

- To one of the four major papal basilicas
- To one of the three basilicas in the holy land.
- To the local cathedral or church designated by the local ordinary



First Reading: Malachi 3:1–4 Second Reading: Hebrews 2:14–18

Simeon recognizes the infant Jesus as the promised Messiah.

#### **Family Connection**

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Discuss with the family the persons of Simeon and Anna as they meet Jesus. (Luke 2: 25–40)

Because Simeon and Anna lived lives of prayer and fasting in the Temple, they were filled with the Spirit of God. That is why they were able to identify Jesus as the Savior even though Jesus was only a baby. To these two holy people, he was recognizable as the Redeemer who had been promised. Simeon described Jesus as "a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel."

We too are called to recognize Jesus as Lord. Together as a family discuss ways to recognize Jesus as Lord by praying and attending Mass, fasting, and serving others. As a family, decide on one specific sacrifice you can make in order to alleviate the suffering or need of someone you know.




